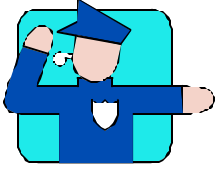

The next Citizens Law Enforcement Academy will begin Tuesday, February 26, and run for 12 consecutive weeks. Call Sector Patrol

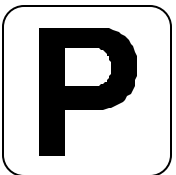
Officer Paul Ellul to enroll (947-7786). Last year's academy was a huge success.

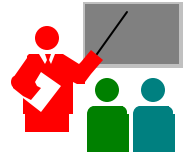
WALTER KULASH
